II. Background of the processing / Indication of the purpose for which the personal data are to be processed / Legal basis of processing / Categories of recipients of personal data:

For the purpose of a proper conduct of academic appointment procedures according to the provisions of the university's Statute "Academic Appointment Procedure and Tenure-Track-Positions", the JKU processes the submitted personal data of applicants.

Legal basis for processing of this personal data are the provisions of the University Act of 2002 and the Statute of the JKU, which is based on it.

Recipients of the personal data concerned are exclusively the organisational units provided in the Statute for conducting the academic appointment procedures, such as referees and committee members, respectively within the scope of their procedural role.

III. Indication of the criteria for determining the retention period:

Personal data of the party concerned is stored according to the criteria for the retention period, such as the required verification of the correct conduct of procedures for possible disputes, for up to three years after the verification exists.

IV. Information on the rights of those concerned:

Under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), you have the following rights:

- Right to information
- Right to correction and deletion
- Right to restriction of processing
- Right to object
- Right to data portability
